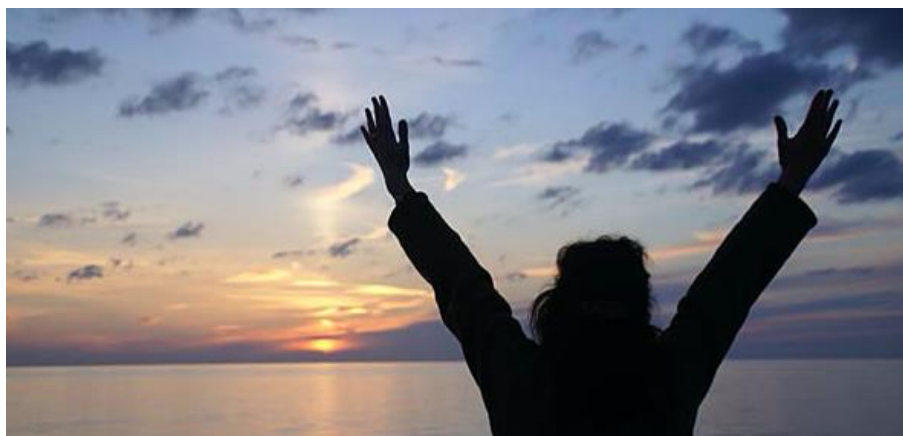
**Terry Waite visits
Christ Church, Oyster Bay
Sunday, August 7th
following the 10 a.m. Eucharist**



Terry Waite CBE (Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire) will be visiting Christ Church, Oyster Bay, on Sunday, August 7. He will speak and take questions at a special coffee hour immediately following the 10:00 am Eucharist that day.

As the Archbishop of Canterbury's special envoy, Terry became famous for his skills in negotiating the release of hostages in the aftermath of the Iranian Revolution of 1979. Next he successfully negotiated the release of hostages taken in Libya. In January 1987, on a similar mission to Beirut, he was himself captured by a Jihadist group and washeld hostage for 1763 days - nearly five years - mostly in solitary confinement. He was released in November 1991.

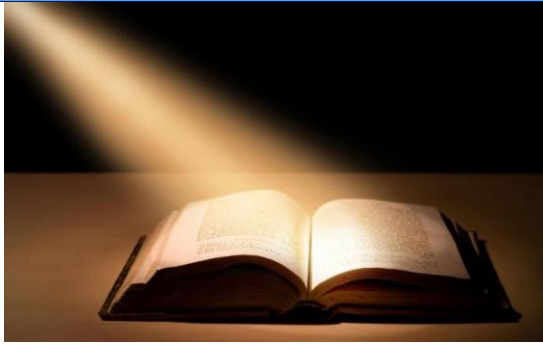
