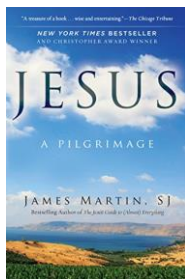

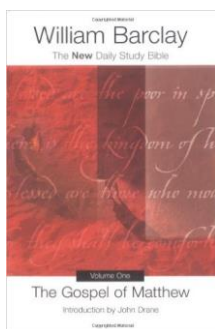

This day will engage church Wardens and Vestry members in a lively reflection on their responsibilities as office-holders at the church.

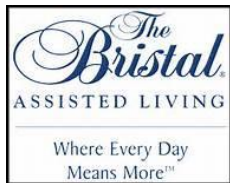
