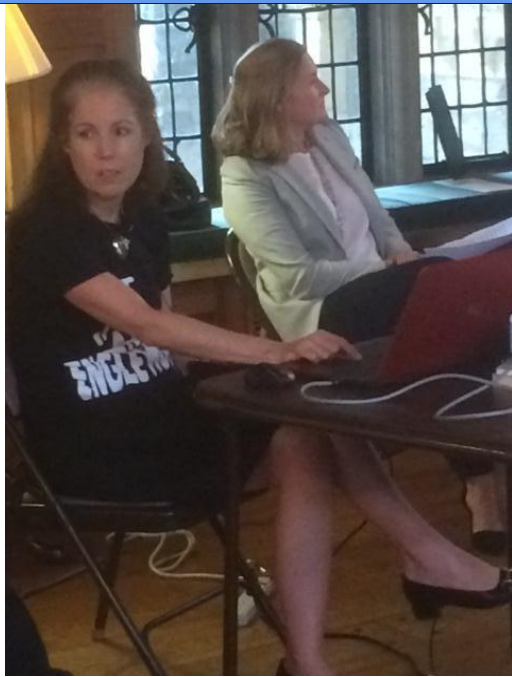


Living in An Endangered Population

Nativity dear to them and it will be framed and all hung together here at church.



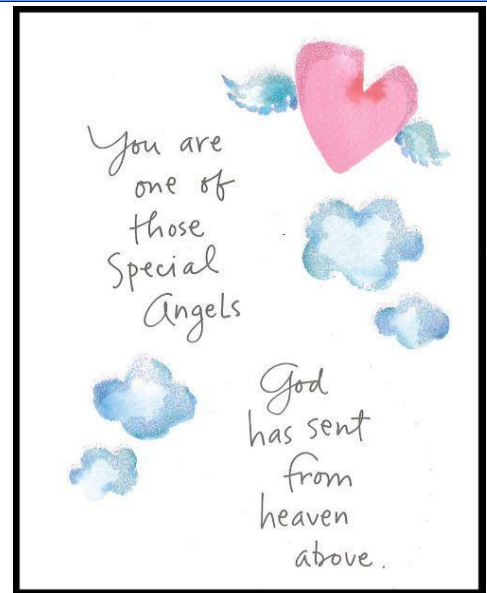
