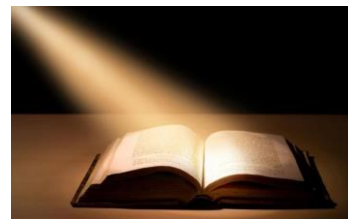

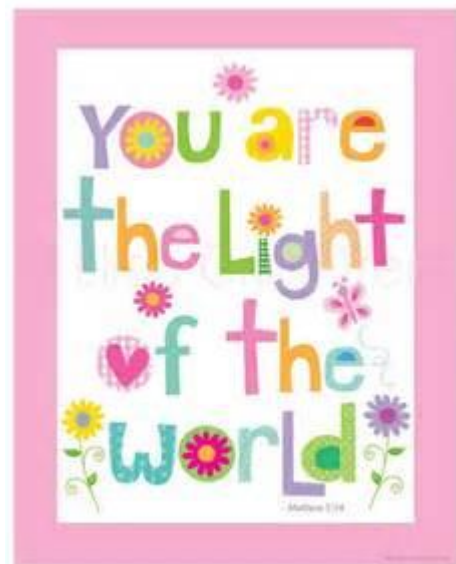

## **DANIEL HYDE IN AN ORGAN RECITAL Saturday, October 22, 2016 at 3:00 pm CHRIST CHURCH OYSTER BAY**



Christ Church Oyster Bay is pleased to welcome Daniel Hyde who will give the Canon Robert T. Hollett Memorial Organ Recital on Saturday October 22, at 3:00 pm. Daniel, a Fellow of the Royal College of Organists, is the new Director of Music at St. Thomas Church, Fifth Avenue, New York. Previously Organ Scholar at King's College Cambridge and Director of Music at Magdalen College Oxford, Daniel has performed across the UK and the world. Recital engagements have taken him to the USA, Vienna, Finland, Germany, Holland and Australia, where he has performed at all the major venues including the Sydney Opera

House. He has been a concerto soloist with the BBC Philharmonic and the Britten Sinfonia. He has appeared at the BBC Proms on numerous occasions, and made his solo debut there in 2010, performing Bach's Canonic Variations at the organ of the Royal Albert Hall. In the 2014/15 season, he performed the complete organ works of JS Bach to inaugurate the new Dobson organ in Merton College Chapel Oxford.

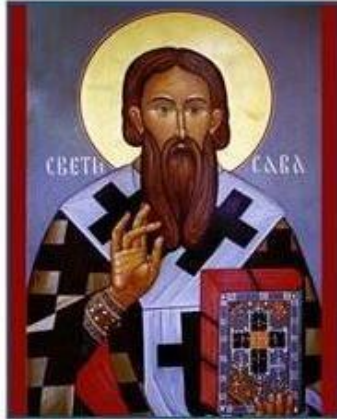

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

In the midst of a disturbing and extremely volatile political season filled with rhetoric that has created new lows for our nation and shame on our national character, I am calling for an octave of prayer throughout the Diocese of Long Island.

The octave will begin on All Saints' Day (Nov. 1) and continue to Election Day (Nov. 8). I am asking each church community to gather for prayer at least once during the octave, inviting the entire community across all denominations and faiths, to gather for a celebration of the Holy Eucharist and community prayer for our nation.

I am asking those who are able in each parish to use this time for fasting, abstinence and deliberate prayer, and to make use of all the resources our faith provides us to refocus on God's will and purpose. We are God's people in this time and place. It falls upon us to respond to negativity, bigotry, and hate with prayer and loving service. Let us pray for our nation - for its direction and future as we prepare to elect our next president.

"God bless America" must be our prayer, not merely a political slogan.

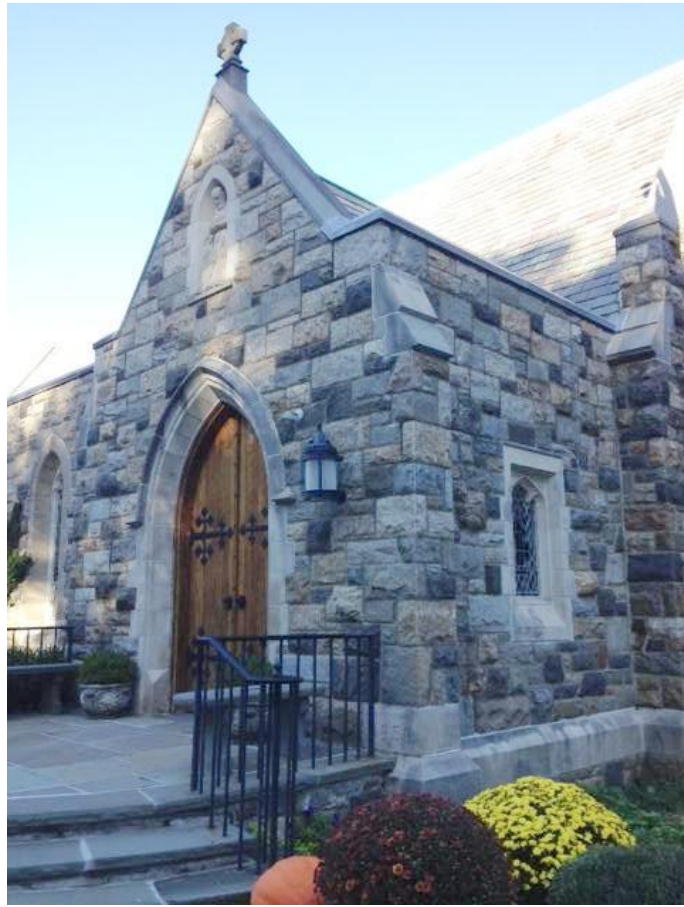
