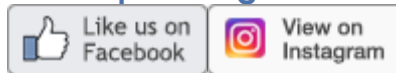

Jesus and Jackson Pollack

Travis Apple is a talented young artist and I am an old art history major! So when I saw his salt map I was double amazed!

First off-lots of people say they could do what Jackson Pollock did, throwing a bucket of paint onto a canvas. But I always felt Pollock's art sprung from a divine silence, "*be still and know I am God*". Despite Pollock's well documented issues, I felt he had a profound connection to God.

The Met exhibited Pollock's sketches some years ago in which he copied El Greco's famous Jesus series depicting the road from Annunciation to The Resurrection. This is evidence of a connection, surely.

So when I saw Travis' salt map depiction of Galilee I was speechless. To me this young person's Pollock-like style was teaching how Gospel spirit powerfully emanated from Galilee. I felt it saying, "Look at Galilee, the place that "got" Jesus! And the way Travis' rounded, galaxy of paint drippings makes a BIG statement--Is Jesus the center of your life like it is here for the people of Galilee? Travis' paint drips aren't just spilled paint--they are the "Good News!"

Travis may not know a lot about Pollock yet, but his Galilee salt map surely shows the joy of taking a paint can and splashing our limitless love for others across a massive canvas of our lives!
