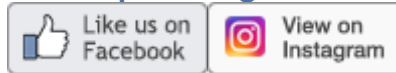

# ICON WRITING WORKSHOP & RETREAT

**Peter Pearson** is an American icon painter, author, and teacher of icon painting. He has created hundreds of icons for private collectors, churches, and other institutions throughout the world. Peter has been painting icons for nearly 50 years, and has authored three books on iconography. In addition, he shares his experience with others through his workshops and retreats. His simple, organized methods are the distillation of what he has learned from all those who mentored him along the way. He has learned from nearly a dozen iconographers from Byzantine, Slavic, and Coptic backgrounds. His passion for this art is apparent and highly contagious.

Byzantine icons are mysterious, and they invite us to just gaze upon their transcendent beauty. Instead of simply presenting us with photographic images of human beings, we are presented with idealized renderings of the human form communicating what it might look like to encounter one who has been transformed by God's grace. In them we see through God's eyes rather than from the human perspective.

Our subject matter for this workshop will be a copy of a Russian icon known as **Mother of God with the Christ Child** (in a "Tenderness" pose). Following Peter's guidance and instruction, every student will complete their own icon from start to finish. In our time together, we will pray and paint. We will learn a bit about history, theology and a great deal about technique following a step-by-step process. **No prior experience is required and everyone is welcome to participate.**
