The Prodigal Father

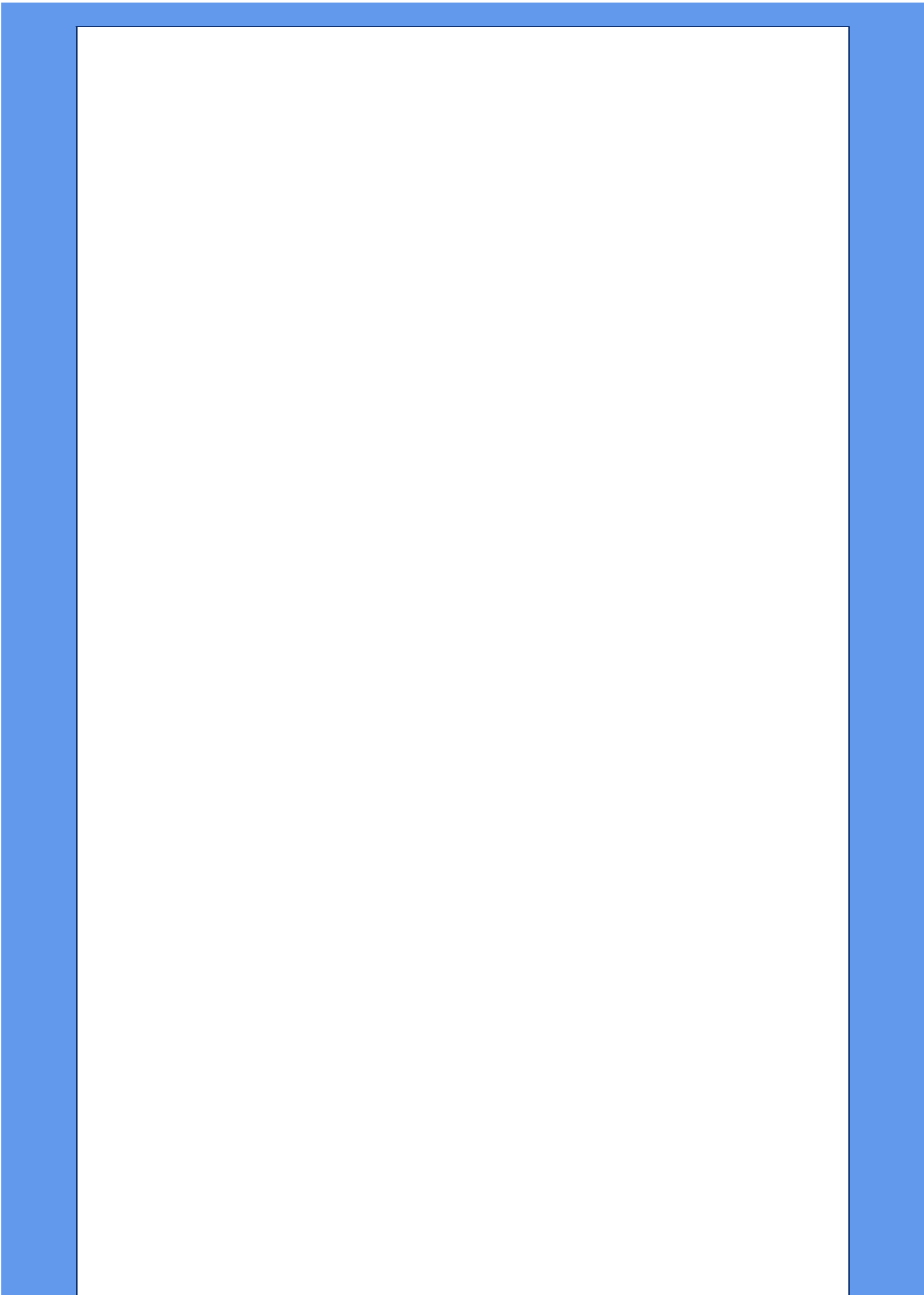
Jairus
