Dear Parishioners and Friends,

When we last wrote April 7th daily COVID cases across the nation and around the globe were steadily on the rise with no visibility or end in sight. Today we are comforted to see hospitalizations and death rates in the hardest hit regions trending in a better direction and citizens of many nations sighing with some relief that the worst of the virus may now have passed. Certainly the lost loved ones, health complications and economic difficulty will be felt for some time to come and the threat of a second wave lingers. However, as the clouds begin to part, and the spring sun shines through, we can optimistically now begin to look forward.


SUNDAY SCHOOL & FAMILY OFFERINGS CLICK HERE
